The race was established in 1974. Since then it has grown into an iconic event in the city. Today around 40,000 athletes participate each year.

THE ROUTE

The course starts and finishes near the Brandenburg Gate. You will run past the JVA Moabit, Reichstag, Mitte Berlin Dom, Fern She Turm, Sudstern, Rathaus Schoneburg, Rheinbabenallee, and the Kaiser Wilhelms building.

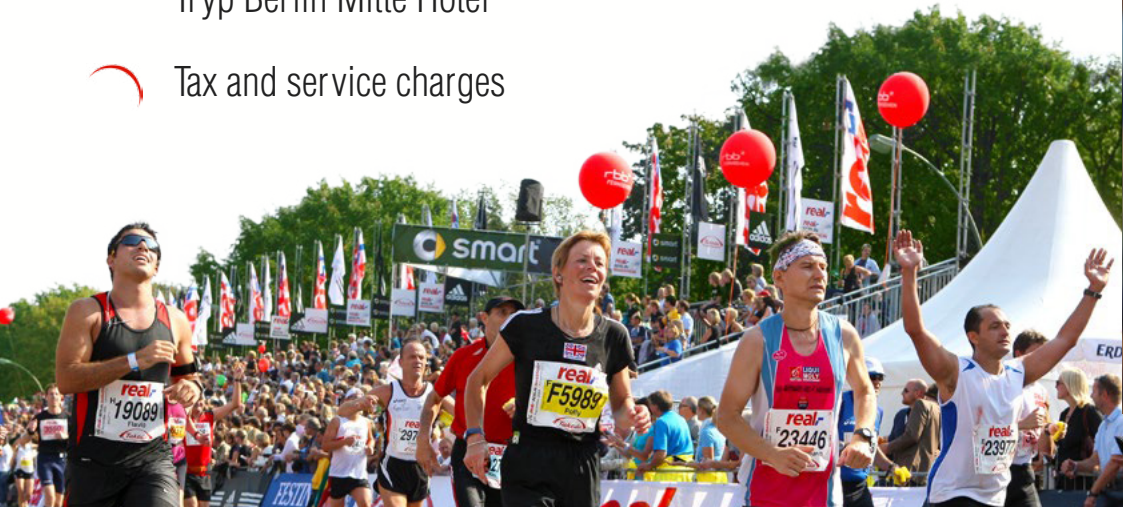
There is so much to enjoy with the BMW Berlin Marathon. As one of the marathon majors it attracts a large field of participants, from weekend warriors to world record holders. The course is flat and fast, and in fact, is home to the current World Record time!

Running through this historic city enables you to see the remnants of the Berlin Wall, the Reichstag and the Brandenburg Gate. The race is well organised, with regular aid stations. You will be cheered on by over a million spectators lining up along the streets!

Prices

Amendments/changes

Cancellations

All payments are non-refundable. We strongly recommend you take out 'Deposit protection/cancellation cover' insurance to cover you for deposits paid, this covers up to payments of \$2500 (subject to the terms and conditions of your policy), after which you can upgrade to full insurance. Please see policy for full details. You may prefer to arrange your own insurance, please check with your insurer if they cover for deposit protection, and if they cover for the actual marathon. Many do not, our insurer does subject to the Terms and Conditions of the policy. The right is reserved to cancel the tour prior to departure with a full refund made as full settlement to the passenger.
